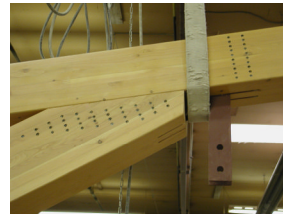

**Wood materials used:**

- Dimensional lumber for all wall framing and some roof framing
- TJI's for roofs
- Glulam posts for point loads
- Glulam beams/trusses in gym
- Plywood sheathing
- Birch plywood on lower gym walls
- Maple shelving in library shelves and desk
- Spruce slats in classroom ceilings
- Cedar tongue and groove in roof soffits
- Maple window trims
- Maple kindergarten cubbies
